Summer groups and camps

June 20th – August 5th

- **Summer Camp Sessions: July 24th-July 28th and July 31st-Aug 4th**
 - We are offering two camp sessions for children 3-5 or 5-8 years of age with groups for those who do *and* do not have significant language delays. These half-day camps (9:00-12:30) will focus on teaching social thinking, social communication, cooperative play, crafts, and flexibility.
 - The older group will include a focus on school preparation for kids entering kindergarten or first grade. We will practice transitions, routines, centers, circle time, independent work, emotional regulation, sharing, and social skills.
- **Fitness Friends: Tuesdays 4:00-5:30**
 - A group for ages 8-13 who are developing social skills and learning to build friendships through physical and athletic engagement.
- **Super Stars: Wednesdays 12:00-3:00 and Thursdays 10:00-1:00**
 - A group for teens ages 13-18 who are building their communication, academic, and social skills.
- **Digital Meet Up: Saturdays 10:30-12:00**
 - A group for teens with an interest in gaming, videos, and technology. We will work to develop face-to-face interaction skills through sharing common digital interests.



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
